Be prepared for your entries to be tasted - they may not be returned in pristine condition.

If there are insufficient worthy entries in a category, no rosettes will be awarded.

Entries can be accepted between 11 and 11.30 only. They should be collected after 13.00.

VEGETABLES – we are looking for same, same, same when it comes to entries.

Brassicas – 2 identical e.g. 2 Savoy, 2 round red cabbages, 2 pointed red cabbages, 2 white cauliflowers, 2 kohlrabi, 2 calabrese

Aubergine – 2 identical e.g. 2 Moneymaker, 2 Black Enorma

Alliums – 3 identical e.g. 3 white onions, 3 red onions, 3 heads of white garlic, 3 heads of purple garlic, 3 heads of shallots, 3 leeks

Roots – 3 identical e.g. 3 Nantes carrots, 3 red beetroot, 3 golden beetroot, 3 parsnips, 3 radishes

Chilli peppers – 5 identical e.g. 5 Scotch bonnet

Sweet peppers – 3 identical e.g. 3 Bell Boy, 3 Big Banana

Potatoes – 5 identical e.g. 5 Charlotte, 5 King Edward

Cucumbers – 2 identical e.g. 2 Flamingo, 2 Burpless Tasty Green

Courgettes – 3 identical e.g. 3 Defender, 3 Gold Rush

Legumes – 5 identical e.g. 5 runner beans, 5 green French beans, 5 purple French beans, 5 safari beans, 5 okra, 5 pea pods

Sweetcorn – 2 identical cobs

Tomatoes – 5 identical e.g. 5 Sungold, 5 Roma

Other – 5 small or 3 large of the same variety e.g. Florence Fennel

Wonky vegetable – 1 whatever - the wonkier the better!

FRUIT – we are looking for same, same, same when it comes to entries

Eating Apples – 5 identical e.g. 5 Russets

Small plate of soft fruit – e.g. raspberries, blackberries

Other fruit – 2 identical e.g. 2 quinces, 2 medlar

Grapes – 2 bunches

FLOWERS

3 identical dahlias in a small vase (up to 20 cms.)

My plot in a small vase (up to 20 cms.) Can be whatever you grow on your plot.

PRESERVES

Jam – 1 jar mainly made from produce from your plot e.g. blackberry and apple

Chutney – 1 jar mainly made from produce from your plot e.g. tomato, apple
